1. May require "Electrical" license. Internal electrical work to the sign/billboard does not require an "Electrical" license, however, the final connection to the power source does.
2. Cleaning only. Any disassembly/modification/repair/replacement requires licensure.
3. Communications Towers - require a "Structural Framing" license classification. If a building is needed in connection with the tower, a "Building" license classification shall be required. If a concrete slab or foundation is needed, a "Concrete" classification shall be required.
4. Non-water based systems only. Water based systems require licensure.
5. Does not include asphalt or concrete surfaces which require licensure.
6. If related repair work is performed on a commercial structure, then a licensed building general contractor must do the work.
7. Assembly and setting only. Connections to utilities, structural modifications and concrete work may require licensure.
