

NCEES EXAM UPDATES

PE Chemical Engineering – The NCEES PE Chemical Engineering exam is now offered *exclusively* via computer-based testing (CBT). CBT provides greater convenience for examinees, uniform testing conditions, and enhanced security.

Registration for the Chemical PE exam is always open and available through your MyNCEES account. SC candidates must apply with the Board for approval to take the exam, prior to registering with NCEES.

Testing is provided year-round at approved Pearson VUE test centers. The first CBT appointments will begin January 2, 2018. The total appointment time is 9 hours. The actual exam lasts 8 hours; the other hour allows time for administrative tasks, including a tutorial and an optional 50-minute break.

The computer-based PE Chemical exam contains 80 questions. It is a supplied-reference exam. A searchable electronic [PE Chemical Reference Handbook](#) will be displayed on the monitor during the exam. No other material will be allowed in the exam room.
