Members of the SC Soil Classifiers Advisory Council are appointed by the Department. The primary responsibility of Council members is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public of South Carolina.

Professional members of the Council must be a citizen of the United States, licensed and residing in the State of South Carolina, actively engaged in the practice of soil classifying for a period of ten years and in a position of responsible charge of soil classification for a period of at least six years.

- Professional and technical society activities.
- Civic and humanitarian activities.
- Continuing competence.
- General personal data.
- References or letters of recommendation, if available.
